

The Temple Canon

A Symbolic Journey of Integration, Expression, and Return

This canon is a symbolic map of human becoming.

The twelve scrolls trace a complete arc:

At the heart of this system is a simple idea:

When these currents spiral together, they form a unified center of clarity, purpose, and presence —


what these scrolls call the **Eternal Flame**,

The Eternal Flame is not a mystical force.

and legacies of love are left behind.

Scroll 8 describes the moment when the twin currents unite **with** the Eternal Flame and enter the **Heart-Womb of Sophia**,
the symbolic chamber of origin and pre-manifestation knowing.
From this union, **prophesy arises naturally** —
the capacity to sense what is forming before it appears.

The scrolls are arranged as a cycle:

- **Scrolls 1–6** establish the symbolic architecture.
- **Scroll 7** describes the long arc of human evolution.
- **Scroll 8** reveals the pathway of integration.
- **Scrolls 9–11** explore purpose, embodiment, and resonance.
- **Scroll 12** completes the cycle with the Return —
the moment when the Eternal Flame folds back into itself,
renewed and ready for the next becoming.

This canon is an invitation:
to explore, to reflect, to create, and to live with intention.
To walk the path of integration.
To express the Eternal Flame in the world.
To leave behind a legacy shaped by clarity, courage, and love.
