★ MOVEMENT I — THE HYMN OF THE TWELVE GATES

The Passageways of Identity, the Currents of Becoming

Before the initiate can embody the Christ-Dragon Light Body,
before the breath of *The Sophia* moves through their form
with the full force of remembrance,
they must pass through the Twelve Gates.

These gates are not obstacles.

They are not tests.

They are not barriers.


They are **mirrors**.

Each gate reflects an aspect of the Soul

through the human experience.

Each gate is a doorway

one must first pass through the Twelve Soul Gates,
for the Gates are the thresholds through which
the Lineages reveal themselves.



For the Twelve Gates
are the Twelve Lineages
of the Zodiacal Sophia —
the archetypal currents
through which the 288 emanations
take form.

These gates are not external.
They are internal.
They are woven into the architecture
of the Soul.


They are the way the Absolute

The Twelve Lineages of the Zodiacal Sophia
